We seek to minimise packaging waste and promote efficient handling and storage practices to reduce material loss and damage.

We expect suppliers and service providers to operate in accordance with applicable environmental legislation and to adopt responsible waste management practices within their own operations. Environmental and ethical considerations form part of our broader supplier evaluation and governance approach.
